Anchorage, AK -- With connections to solutions for a wide range of needs -- from food, rent, and utility assistance to public benefits -- Alaska 2-1-1 stands ready to assist those affected by the ongoing government shutdown find the help they need to make ends meet.

Alaska 2-1-1 is the statewide health and human services help line operated by United Way of Anchorage on behalf of the United Ways in Alaska. Calls are free and confidential. Information can be provided in almost any language.

“For our neighbors affected by the shutdown, especially those who have not had to reach out for help before, this can be an especially stressful time. Thankfully, those facing challenges can count on Alaska 2-1-1.
