United Way board elects officers, six directors to new terms

Anchorage AK – Natasha Pope, vice president and community relations manager at First National Bank Alaska, was elected chair, and Alex McKay, vice president of programs at the Rasmuson Foundation, was elected vice chair of the United Way of Anchorage board of directors.

Pope and McKay were elected at the board’s January 20 meeting. The directors also elected Laurie Butcher, senior vice president finance at Alaska Communications as treasurer, and Beth Stuart, office managing partner at KPMG, as secretary.

In addition to the officers, five directors were elected to second three-year terms – Greg Deal, regional president of Wells Fargo; Bill Falsey, former Anchorage municipal manager; Darlene Gates, CEO of ExxonMobil Alaska; Mike Huston, executive vice president at Northrim Bank; and Ed Ulman, CEO of Alaska Public Media.

Former chair and longtime board member Belinda Breaux recently retired from Alyeska Pipeline Service Co. was elected to a third three-year term. Board terms run through December 2023. Board officers serve one-year terms.
